What is iPledge?

The **iPledge Campaign** is a church-wide stewardship campaign that we want to employ as a body of Christ to help us achieve financial freedom as a ministry. During this campaign, we will collectively commit to give according the measure of grace we have each received from the Lord. Throughout, the **iPledge Campaign**, our goal is to raise monies over and above our regular tithe and offering. This campaign will help us to realize financial freedom and allow us to giving to increase our ministry efforts.

Why iPledge?

Scripture states that the borrower will always be slave to the lender (Proverbs 22:7). Our goal is therefore to become, and continue to operate, debt free. The **iPledge Campaign** is the first leg of this journey! Additionally we will be able to better equip our leaders and to provide better resources for more effective ministry that will help to achieve our vision.

Who can take part in iPledge?

Every person that is a part of this local congregation is invited and encouraged to be a part of the **iPledge Campaign**! This financial freedom initiative is designed so that "Even though we may not all push with the same force, we can all push in the same direction." Since nothing will be impossible if we are of one mind, the goal is for 100% participation. No one needs to feel left out.

How will you benefit from iPledge?

As our church strives for financial freedom and good stewardship, we believe congregants must realize the same blessing. The **iPledge Campaign** has committed to availing opportunities for families of our church to be given free fiscal training and resources.

How does iPledge work?

Each family unit (anyone over 18) in our church will be given a commitment card.
